Activating a second-instance IronCAD License, What do I do?

This bulletin is intended to explain how to activate your second-instance IronCAD license. **Key note** is the second-instance license is only available for IronCAD customers that are on an active ironCAD support plan, such as Armor Advantage or Subscription Service. If you do not have active support plane, you are not eligible for the second-instance license option.

The second-instance license allows you as an active support subscriber to load the IronCAD solution onto a home computer or laptop for tele-commuting. This allows you to transport your IronCAD to wherever you need the ability to continue your designing.

IMPORTANT to note, that if you lapse on your support plan or let it expire, the second-instance license will cease to operate.

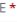
1 The first thing is to request a license direct from the IronCAD website using the link here: <https://www.ironcad.com/licensing-and-activation/license-extension-request>

Make sure you select the "L2- Home or Mobile License" option under the LICENSE TYPE dropdown.
